Use this form to help you *strategize your meetings with your advisors, peers, and personal networks so that you can plan your time at HGSE to fill your gaps in skills, knowledge, and qualifications*. This will ultimately assist you in becoming the candidate of choice with your chosen employers.

Completing the Form:

1. Fill in the Working Identity section with your preferred roles and sectors. Start with your ideal career in the Plan A column and use the remaining columns for additional career options.
2. Fill in the areas you need to develop from your Gap Analysis.
3. Fill in the proposed resources for classes, internships, and extracurricular areas that you are considering.
4. Determine the people whose advice you will seek to help you choose your classes, extracurricular activities, and internship sites.

Discussing the Form:

1. Use this form to generate discussion in HGSE Hub Sector groups to learn from alumni, peers, and Career Services staff.
2. Make appointments to meet with advisors and people that may be helpful.
3. Tell your advisor about your working identity, gap analysis and the classes, resources, and internships that you are considering. Ask your advisor for her/his input on the options that you are considering.
4. Take notes on your discussion with your advisor.
5. Keep these completed forms for your records and to revisit with your advisor(s) during subsequent meetings.
